City Manager Wheeler reported that McCraw Oil had delivered the diesel tank, and it is ready for use.

City Manager Wheeler reported that the generator for the water pump station has been set up.

City Manager Wheeler reported that Brad Carroll's Tree Service will be working on the streets that were not trimmed during phase 1 of the project.

City Manager Wheeler presented the monthly Improvements and Maintenance report and discussed city improvements that need to be addressed. She reported that the city crew has been digging ditches and replacing culverts.

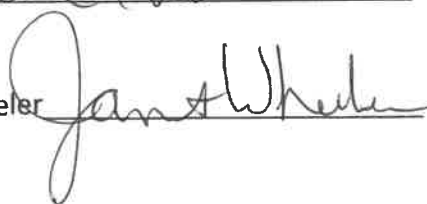
